LOCATION

- From 101 Northbound, exit Casitas Pass Rd. Right on Carpinteria Ave. Left on Linden.
- From 101 Southbound, exit Carpinteria Ave. Left on Carpinteria Ave. Right on Linden.
- Check in after 3PM. Check out before 11AM.

KEYS

Door and pool keys are in the lockbox attached to the front door knob. The code is **8051**. Please lock the door when going out and try to keep from bringing sand into the unit when your return. Be certain to replace the key and close the latch when you check out. The parking key card is located in the upper kitchen drawer.

PARKING

- Gated lot key is located in top kitchen drawer. Please replace before leaving (\$50 lost key penalty).
- Important: Streets around the property are swept is every Tuesday from 9AM to 11AM. Do not park on the street during that time or you will get ticketed.
- There is parking in the Carpinteria State Beach lots across the street and at the end of Linden. A large public lot is located adjacent to the Amtrak station.


TV on and off: Use either Cox remote.

Cable TV

CHECKING OUT

- Please hang all used towels on coat rack or pile on top of hallway cabinet. Leave unused towels in place in bathroom.
- Trash bins are located near the private parking entrance gate.
- Return key to lockbox. The code for the lockbox is "8051".

MANAGEMENT

If you encounter any issues or problems, <u>please contact us directly (by phone or e-mail)</u>. The office in the complex is for long-term stays and residents. They can get cranky if their normal routine is disturbed...

HEAT and AIR CONDITIONER

There are two wall heaters with thermostats. Please turn off when leaving for an extended time. The air conditioner is simple to use. Please shut off when going out for an extended time.

TRASH

There is a trash bin and a recycle bin in the locked parking area. Please empty waste baskets when you check out. Thanks.

POOL AND SPA

Use the brass key attached to the key ring to get into the pool area. The pool is located next to the office, down the stairs and left at the sidewalk. The office does not have any spare keys.

BARBEQUE

Propane barbeque is outdoors down the corridor to the left as you exit the condo. It you may need to use a match and turn on the propane tank. Be sure to turn propane tank off when done

LAUNDRY

The laundry room is in back behind the pool. Machines and detergent are coin-operated.

BICYCLES

• Our three bicycles are located in carport just below the condo. Two are blue and shackled together. Use the key on the key ring in the top kitchen drawer. The combo for single blue Specialized lock is: 8051. Be sure to lock the bikes when going out and return the key to the drawer. NOTE: If you find the tires are low on air, there is a car repair shop up a block on Linden and to the right. They won't mind if you use their air.

WATER

Southern California is in the midst of a serious drought. The city of Carpinteria is monitoring and rationing residential water usage. Please be conscientious.
