

When printed notes are squeezed together and nearly touch, SmartScore may automatically join them together and form two separate voice lines (black and red).

NOTE: Default "horizontal offset" spacing can be changed in the Options section of the Begin Recognition dialog window. However, we recommend leaving the standard default as is.

To "unglue" two notes that have been joined together during recognition...

- Use the Selector tool and drag to select & highlight the two "joined" notes (black and red).
- Hit the "Y" key. This will separate them and notes should then be the same color.
- Hold the SHIFT key down to reposition notes horizontally.

NOTE: Selecting 2 notes of the same voice and hitting "Y" will join them into 2 voices.

Deleting and Inserting Dots of Prolongation

- Hit the "D" key to activate "Dot of Prolongation". Hit the "X" key to enter Delete mode.
- Click on the note head containing the dot you wish to remove.
- Hit the "D" key again to reactivate "Insert dot".
